We are just days away from the official start to the Snowcross season. Hundreds of racers and thousands of fans will all converge in Duluth Minnesota Friday for the first round of the ISOC Snowcross series. This is a three day event held at the top of Spirit Mountain, a ski facility that hosts this event each year. The team is pumped to be here and ready to see how they shape up against the best in the world as all the top racers from Canada, United States and Europe are here. This year we have Ryan Hunt and Taylor McCoy representing us in the Pro Class. Isaac St Onge will compete in Sport, Brooklyn Karkoulas in Junior Girls and Yanick Boucher in Snowbike.



The team showed up a week ago to begin testing the all new Ski Doo race sled here at Quadna Mountain. It's a great facility with lodging right on site so no time is wasted on travel to and from the track. Team mechanics Glen Goodale and Tom Wilson have been busy working with the support of BRP factory technicians, dialing in the new sleds. Trying to find the perfect set up for each rider before they line up to race. We have also been fortunate enough to have support from the team at Enzo Suspension.
