What an incredible experience. Now that the Bailey Team has been back from the X Games in Colorado we have had a chance to digest the magnitude of being involved in such an incredible event as the X Games.

We could not be prouder of how our rider Yanick Boucher performed all weekend.

When commenting on X Games, team owner Stuart Hunt had this to say,

“Flying back from Aspen, I had time to reflect on the experience at X Games. It is like no other event, I or the team, has ever been to. We had so much fun as it gave us the chance to go do some skiing, backcountry riding on the snowbike and testing our Husqvarna Canada race bike equipped with a Yeti Snow MX kit which was working great for us in the mountains. The racing was even better for me, I was able to qualify for the final after getting 4th in my heat race. I didn't get the best of starts in the final and visibility was bad on track but I was able to finish up in 9th place. Overall I'm super happy about my first X Games experience and I hope I can come back and do even better next year! Huge thanks to my team Bailey Motorsports for making this whole trip possible.”

A special thanks to Yeti Snow MX and the development team at Camso for working with us to get the right set up in the Yeti kit. With their support and the hard work done at Flybyu Motorsports on the bike build, we had a set up that was ready for the biggest stage snowbike racing will see this year.


